

How to repair a damaged capacitor box

How do you fix a faulty capacitor?

Use a screwdriver or piece of metal to short across the legs of the old capacitors, while they are still in the board. This will "short out" any remaining power left in them so they don't spark or shock you while you do the repair. Using a soldering iron, remove the old capacitors. Then solder in the new ones.

How do you remove a faulty capacitor from a circuit board?

Desolder Capacitor Leads: Apply the soldering iron to each lead of the faulty capacitor, melting the solder joints to facilitate removal. Use a desoldering pump or solder wick to remove excess solder and free the capacitor leads from the circuit board.

How do you replace a capacitor?

Trim the leads of the new capacitor so that they are both even, and will sit at about the same height as the old capacitor. Position the new capacitor leads at the holes where the old capacitor was, with the correct polarity. Just like before, press the tip of the soldering iron directly onto the joint in the back of the circuit board.
